One day, four boys were walking in the grounds of Lascaux, an old mansion in southwest France. When their dog fell through a crack in some rocks, the boys went to rescue it and found that the hole led to a cavern. (A) It would prove to be one of the most exciting archaeological discoveries of the 1900s.

News of the discovery traveled fast. People were soon flocking to explore the caves. In all, they found seven underground chambers connected by narrow passageways, with paintings and engravings on the ceilings and walls. A team of top archaeologists soon arrived at the caves. They were amazed by the sensational finding—the paintings dated from around 15000 B.C.E. and were perfectly preserved. The paintings of prehistoric animals captured the world's imagination. They offer us a glimpse of the lives of our ancestors in the distant past. Archaeologists were worried about what to do with the caves. Europe was involved in World War I, so there was no spare money to spend on developing and protecting the site. They decided to seal the caves until after the war.
